



Air Cannon CTE-ACMT

Thank you for your purchase. The CTE Air Cannon is a high flow air device for haunted house or fun house use. The air cannon is a great addition to any professional haunted house or home haunt and runs on standard 110VAC power and compressed air. When triggered, the cannon delivers a very loud blast of air. The effect is extremely startling, and will surprise even the most hard to scare patrons.

CTE constructs products using high quality components and parts. The Air Cannon was designed and built to last many years. All CTE products carry a one (1) year warranty. The Air Cannon is equipped with a seven (7) gallon air reserve tank, welded steel mounting base, steel pipe with Teflon seals, air gauge, safety valve and a high quality electronic valve.

The CTE Air Cannon is shipped assembled and ready to use. You will need to supply a standard air compressor and 110VAC. The following section will guide you through a few simple steps to assist you in setting up your air cannon. Please follow all instructions. They are important to the safety of everyone.

- 1. Unpack product and inspect for damage. If device is damaged, please contact CTE immediately.*
- 2. Mount the Air Cannon to a stable surface using the mounting base located on the bottom of the air reserve tank. It is very important that the Air Cannon be properly secured. If not properly secured, it will move when activated. Mounting hardware has been supplied for your convenience.*
- 3. Connect a female air fitting from your air compressor hose to the male fitting on the rear of the Air Cannon. Then connect the 6' power cable into a 110VAC power source.*
- 4. Power up your air compressor and allow the Air Cannon reserve tank to fill. You may use the regulator on your compressor to adjust the tank pressure. **CTE recommends 80-100 PSI. However, you can set the regulator to the setting that works best for your application. The components used in the Air Cannon are rated for 100 PSI MAXIMUM. DO NOT EXCEED 100 PSI.***
- 5. Once the Air Cannon reserve tank is full, it is ready for operation. To activate the Air Cannon, press the trigger button. When the trigger is depressed the Air Cannon will fire immediately. The Air Cannon needs approximately 30 seconds to 1 minute to refill. This time will depend on the specifications of your air compressor.*

The Air Cannon includes a 15' long manually operated push button trigger, and 5' power cable. If you would like to automate this effect, you can purchase an add-on controller from CTE.

- The Air Cannon is designed to be used on adults only. If the air cannon will be used in areas with small children, only use the manual trigger.
- The Air Cannon must be allowed to recharge before re-firing.
- The Air Cannon is a startle "PROP" and should never be used as a weapon or toy.
- The Air Cannon is extremely loud. Ear protection should be worn whenever possible.
- Never exceed maximum pressure rating of 100 PSI.
- Always secure the unit to the ground or a stationary wall.
- Always use at ground level with barrel pointing no higher than knee level.
- Never insert any object into the valve outlet or barrel.
- Never attempt to fire any object from the air cannon.
- Always disconnect power and air when not in use.
- The air cannon should never be subjected to rain or excessive moisture.
